

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS FOR ONLINE LEARNING AT HOME

Working and learning at home has become a part of our daily life and whilst some days will be more tricky than others, it is important that we all do everything we can to ensure each day can run as smoothly as possible.

Our staff will:

- Provide a weekly plan of learning for any children who are self-isolating
- Set up daily Teams sessions - catch up, maths / English, story time, phonics and 1:1 / small group as needed
- Communicate regularly via phone calls and emails to support parents and their children

Our remote learning policy asks parents to:

- Check their child has all of their logins and passwords
- Check that Microsoft Teams is installed on the device their child will be using
- Check that school has their correct email address
- Check that their child has basic equipment to do their work (pencil, paper, ruler)
- Find a quiet place for their child to work, preferably at a table

In order that the online Teams sessions are useful and successful for ALL children, we expect:

- Children to be dressed appropriately
- Children to leave snacks / breakfast / lunch until after the session has ended
- No child to post inappropriate messages in the 'chat' function
- No child to mute or otherwise try to control the session
- Children to be punctual and prepared for the session
- Parents to be aware of what / who else is in the room which will be seen and heard by everyone, and potentially disrupt learning
