Acceptable Internet Use Agreement

At school children:

- will ask permission from a member of staff before accessing a school device
- will only use the Internet for school and homework
- will not try to run, install or uninstall any software on a school device without prior permission
- will not unplug or move any school device without prior permission
- will not turn off their own or another child's device without prior permission
- will ask for permission before printing
- will not access/play games on school devices without prior permission
- will not access any music/video streaming sites without prior permission
- will not try to circumvent the internet filtering that is put in place
- will not use floppy discs, pen drives, memory sticks or any other removable storage device from outside school unless given permission
- will only e-mail people they know within our school, or people who have been approved by a teacher
- Will only send messages which are polite and responsible.
- Will not give out any personal information such as name, address email etc
- will report any unpleasant material or messages they encounter whilst using the Internet, to their teacher.

At home parent's:

- will educate their child/children about how to navigate the internet safely at home and at school
- will make sure that their child/children will use a school provided device for school work only
- understand that actions taken on devices maybe logged if they do not comply with these responsibilities

Adults at school:

- will supervise children's use of the Internet
- will check computer files and monitor Internet sites that have been visited by children
- will ensure that children's personal information is not published on the Internet
- and that no child can be fully identified from any material that is published on the school's website.
- will use a filter to ensure no inappropriate or offensive material is accessible
- will ensure that the Internet is used at a level appropriate age of the children concerned and that its use is beneficial to the teaching and learning of the pupils within the school
